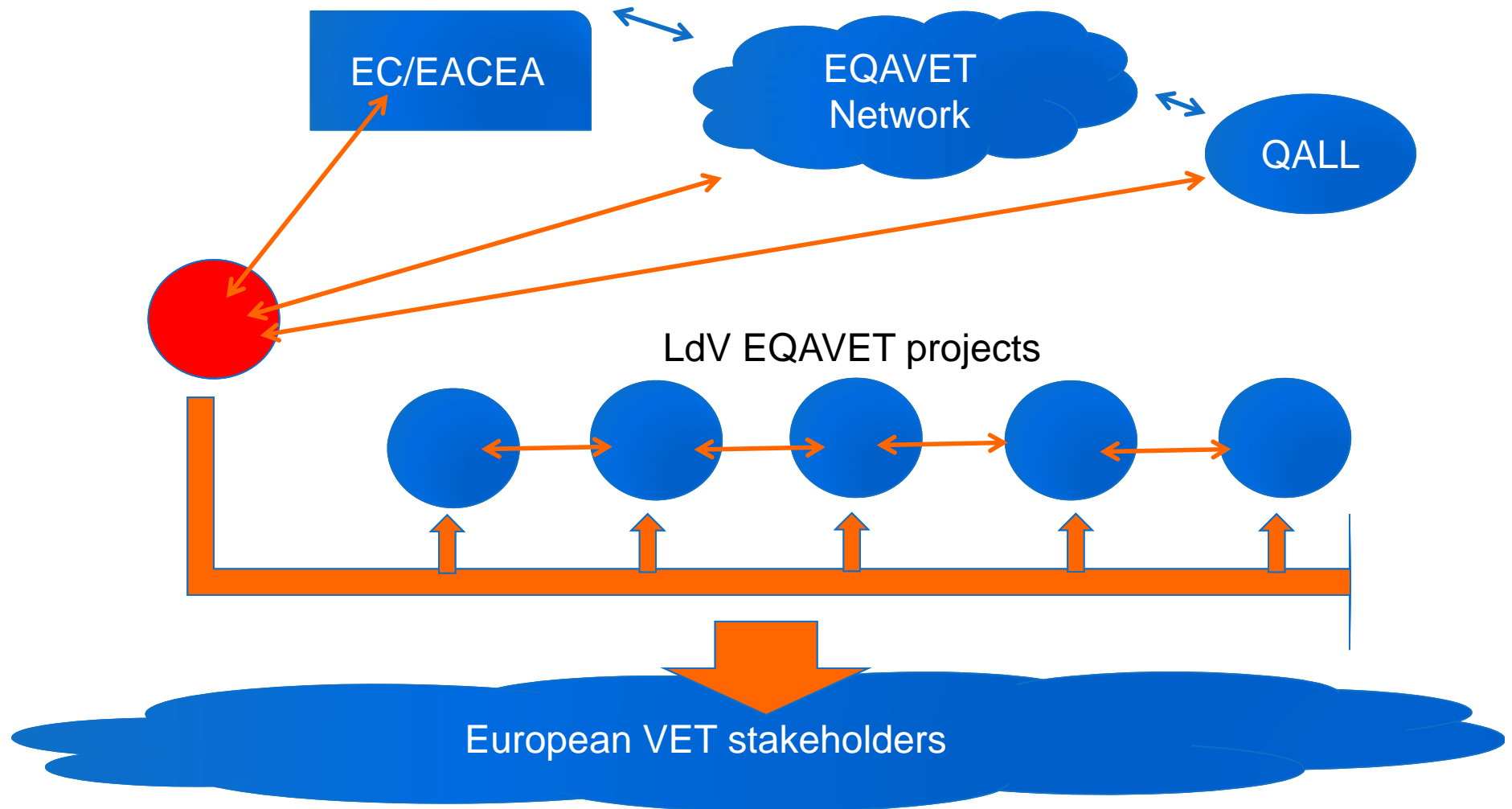

Qualification as a way to Quality (AT)

 - > to guarantee that persons dealing with quality management in VET institutions have the necessary competencies
 - > to make these competencies visible through a certification process.

Supporting the implementation of EQAVET in NL

1. Making at national level an inventory of quality assurance systems and knowledge sharing, EQAVET indicator 1
2. Stimulating a culture of Quality improvement at provider level to do Test and Taste for VET providers (WP3)
3. Promote the EQAVET recommendation in the Netherlands, with a focus on the descriptors (PDCA) and indicators by conferences, workshops, communication strategy, website with marketplace and forum, using social media
4. Strengthen the Dutch Quality Assurance National Reference Point by boosting the activity level and placing EQAVET in the European policy context of the Copenhagen process
5. Involve all stakeholders in QA
6. Include private VET providers and all sectors in the system

Capacity Building the Romanian NRP

1. Elaborating and piloting a communication strategy of the NRP-GNAC in order to implement at national level the EQARF Recommendation, the policies and the instruments elaborated within EQAVET, by cooperation within GNAC, among Partners and with relevant stakeholders.
2. Raising the level of awareness of all stakeholders, by national conferences, regional workshops, project website, database of relevant documents and materials published regarding the implementation of the EQARF Recommendation and the policies and instruments elaborated within EQAVET at national level.
3. Disseminating, via national conferences, regional seminars, project website, database of relevant documents and materials published, the policies and instruments elaborated within EQAVET and by the project partners.

Europanisation of the DE national model

- The project aims to combine the European initiative on quality assurance in vocational education (EQAVET) with the Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBWF) launched national initiative model for quality assurance and quality development.
- The perspectives and experiences of partner countries are included in the national development work in Germany. On the other hand, the partner countries gain suggestions for action and examples of best practice for implementation at home
