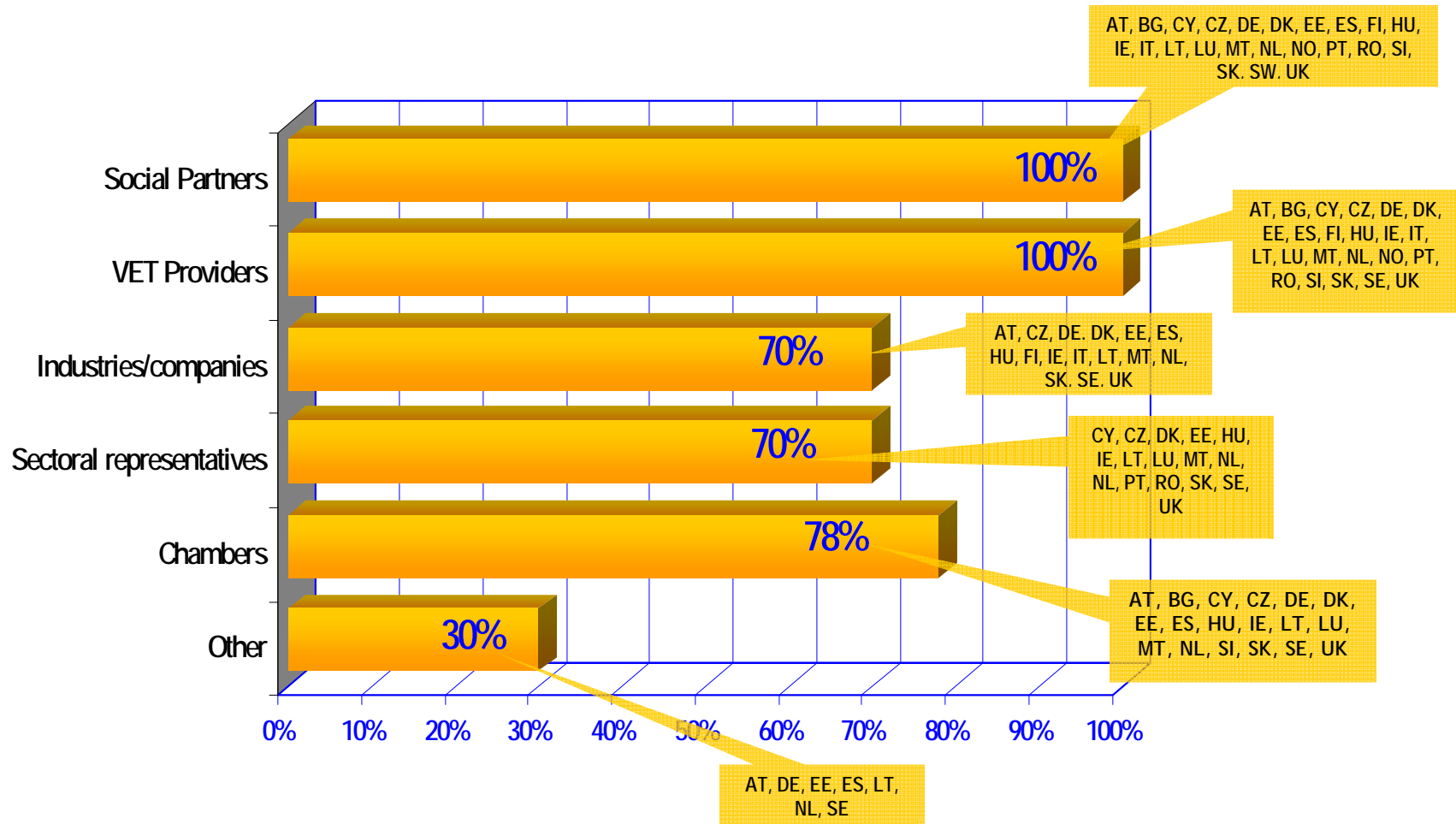


STAKEHOLDERS INVOLVEMENT IN POLICY DEVELOPMENT FOR VET SINCE 2008



The category specified under "other" includes

- AT: Research institutions focussing on VET and representatives of regional school boards
- DE: Schools and universities
- EE: Representatives of municipalities and learners
- FL: Student and teacher organisations
- LT: Policy makers
- NL: Student's representatives and municipalities
- ES: General and Regional administration
- SW: Teachers

The Figure examines which stakeholders have been involved in the review policy process undertaken since 2008 by Member States participating in the Survey, showing that:

- All institutions have engaged with social partner and VET providers in the reform process
- 70% of total national institutions have cooperated with industries/companies and sectoral representatives
- A large majority of institutions have involved chambers (78%)

The high percentages indicate that countries are collaborating with and engaging in a process of consultation with key stakeholders, particularly with labour market representatives. This indicates that countries participating in the Survey are focusing their efforts on improving the quality and attractiveness of VET
