

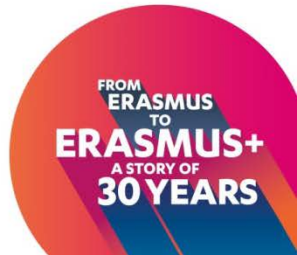

Improving QA and development of work based learning/non-formal apprenticeship in the VET system

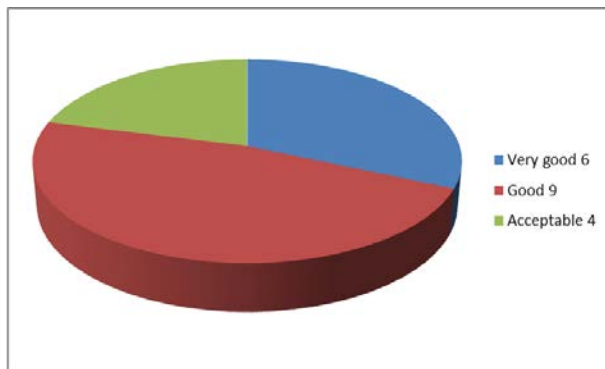
Evaluation and review phase of the QA cycle, VET providers' self-assessment improvements

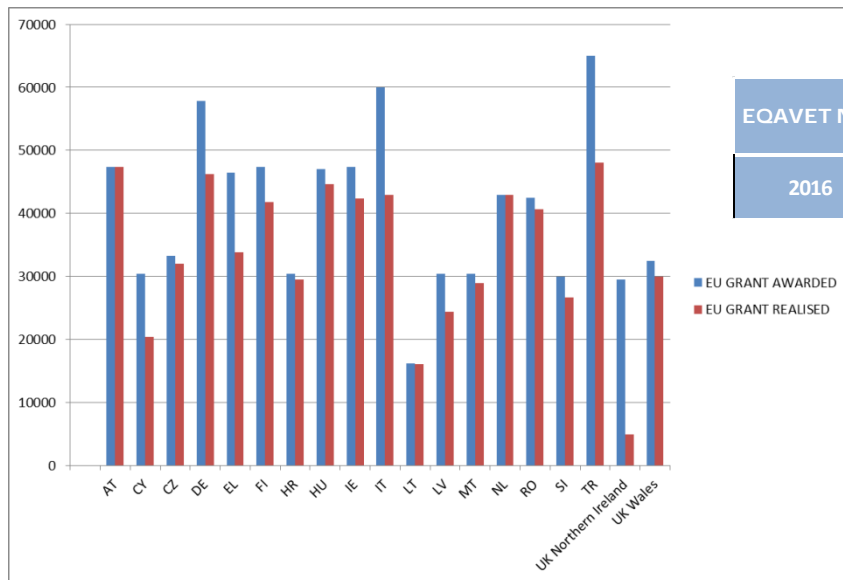
Evaluation procedure

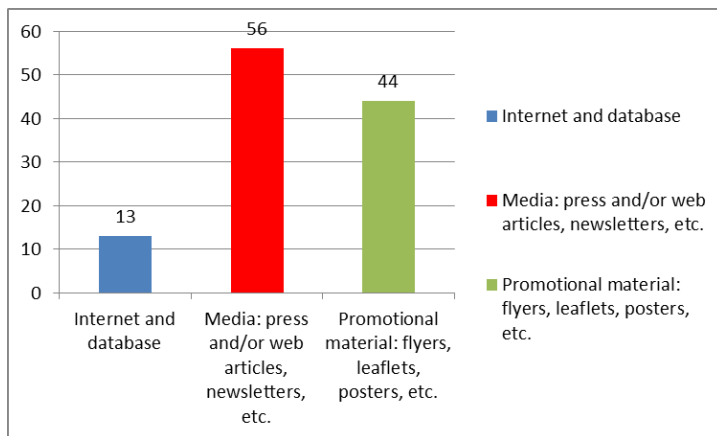

GOOD PRACTICES

- The Exchange and Development Group involving Austria, Finland, Germany, the Netherlands, Romania and UK-Scotland
- Targeted PR activities to support the promotion of EQAVET amongst stakeholders and to enhance its visibility
- Assessment standards of learning outcomes in the sector of tourism developed (EL)
- National EQAVET Experts Network representing the main stakeholders and working to adapt the EQAVET framework to the national context (HU)
- Participatory approach adopted to raise VET providers' involvement and ownership to QA in VET (IE)
- Participants commitment in acting and ambassadors in their respective organizations (IE)
- Policy Networks monitoring check list (IT)
- Baltic countries conference: similarities between the neighboring countries
- Questionnaires and recommendations for the introduction of EQAVET indicators in VET system (LV)
- Thematic seminar on stimulating Erasmus+ projects on quality assurance (NL)
- The detail of the budget for each activity in the project description (RO)
- The policy briefing (result of the PLA on promoting visibility and raising awareness of VET) including key messages for system and provider developments at national and European level (RO)
- Cases of good practice in quality assurance in work based learning: all phases of quality cycle (plan-do-check-act) have been developed and actually implemented (SI)

RECOMMENDATIONS

- Strengthen the project's financial monitoring to avoid as far as possible ineligible expenditure.
- Amendments
- More detailed final report to allow a proper assessment.
- Properly justify in the final report any deviation to the original work programme.
- Develop stronger risk management plans
- Quantitative and qualitative indicators set since the beginning to allow a quantitative assessment during the evaluation phase
